Would you eat one of the world's most \*poisonous fish?

The blowfish known in Japan as fugu is one of the most (1) fish in the sea. Its \*organs are filled with a poison that attacks the body's muscles. The poison is so strong that even just a very small amount can kill a human. [7] People who eat the poison will start to get sick within half an hour. (2a). Then, they will feel a little cold and start to sweat. (2b). (2c) if they do not receive medicine.

(3) (believe that / difficult to / it is / this dangerous animal / is ) a popular food in Japan and a few other East Asian countries. Japanese people eat about 10,000 tons of fugu each year. Fugu can be found on the menus of many Japanese restaurants. People usually eat raw fugu (4) sometimes eat it after cooking it or in a salad.

According to Japanese rules, only cooks with a "fugu license" can serve fugu (much like only people with a driver's license can drive a car). Cooks who want to serve fugu must first train for two to three years. After the training, the cooks take a test. If they pass the test, they can serve fugu at a restaurant, (4) if they do not pass, they cannot serve fugu. Only  $_{(5)}$  of the people who take the test pass it. People believe that this training and test make it safer to eat fugu in restaurants or markets. [7]

To prepare fugu safely, cooks have to separate the poisonous organs from the meat. Fugu cooks slice the fish with a special knife (c) (call) a fugu hiki. If the cook makes a mistake and cuts the organs while he is cooking, the poison will spread to the other parts of the fish. [I] After the cook has \*removed the poison, he puts it in a special bag and locks it in a box.

So what does *fugu* taste like? Some people say that it is the most delicious food they have ever eaten; others say that it is tasteless. There are so many different opinions, but the only way you can know is to eat some yourself — if you want to!
